**OBJECTIVE, SCOPE and THEME**

The aim of SIG 13 is to promote theoretically sound and empirical evidence for moral and democratic education, i.e., moral and democratic education that capitalizes on the research in development, learning, and education, both in school and outside of school settings. The general theme of the symposium is *Moral and Democratic Education and its influence on the society*. Possible themes for submission related to the general title can include:

- Moral development of students, teachers and societies
- Teacher-student interaction in democratic societies
- Teaching methods for moral and democratic education
- Teacher education on moral issues – a tool for fostering democracy in societies
- Social justice at educational work in democratic societies
- Moral and democratic education in multicultural societies
- Issues of methodology and/or assessment of moral education
- Peace education
- Other topics related with moral and democratic education can also be submitted.

## **PROPOSAL FORMATS**

There are two possible presentation formats: Individual papers and posters. Individual papers allow for 20 minutes of oral presentation plus a five minute discussion. Posters will be presented in separate poster sessions (poster size maximum: 140 cm high x 115 cm wide). At the symposium's web site you can find additional information for the technical aspects of submissions.

## **SUBMISSION**

Proposal submission deadline: 1<sup>st</sup> February 2010.

Notification of acceptance: 15<sup>th</sup> March 2010.

A full paper of 5000 to 7000 words will be asked for the contribution (papers or posters) that are accepted for presentation before the Symposium (June 2010).
