### Important Information

**Conference Venue:** All sessions will take place at Dorotheenstraße 24, on the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> floor. Rooms: **1.401, 1.406, 1.301**. The keynotes will take place in the **Reutersaal**.

**Registration Desk:** The registration will be open from 9 a.m. on Wednesday and will be located in Room 1.403 on the 4th floor.

**Restrooms:** The restrooms on the 4<sup>th</sup> floor are located near the entrance area.
