Brandenburger Tor	This iconic neoclassical monument is one of Berlin's most famous landmarks

Alexanderplatz	A major public square with the famous Berlin TV Tower.
Charlottenburg Palace	A stunning baroque palace with beautiful gardens, providing a glimpse into Berlin's royal past.
East Side Gallery	A stretch of the Berlin Wall covered in colourful murals, symbolizing freedom and unity.
Checkpoint Charlie	The famous crossing point between East and West Berlin during the Cold War. There's a museum nearby that provides more insight into the history of the Berlin Wall.
